The adventure includes Jasper and Banff National Parks and the iconic chateau of Lake Louise. Azure blue lakes, glacier covered peaks, thundering waterfalls and deep river valleys highlight this amazing journey.



ITINERARY:

DAY 1 | ARRIVE IN VANCOUVER

You'll have an early start to catch your airport transfer from Perry, OK to Oklahoma City, OK for your 5:20am flight. You will arrive in Vancouver, one of Canada's most beautiful cities. Once you have cleared Canadian Customs and Immigration and met your Tour Manager, board your private coach for a short tour of this beautiful city. See Gastown, Chinatown, and 1000-acre Stanley Park before we check in to our conveniently located hotel (time permitting). Tonight, enjoy a welcome dinner with your travel companions and sample some delicious West Coast cuisine.

DAY 2 | VICTORIA & BUTCHART GARDENS

Rise and shine early this morning as we board our private motor coach for a short drive to the Tsawwassen Ferry terminal where we board a large and comfortable BC Ferry for a spectacular 90-minute cruise through the Gulf Islands to Vancouver Island. On Vancouver Island, explore the gardens and attractions of the world famous Butchart Gardens. In the afternoon, there will be time to view the Parliament buildings, Victoria's beautiful inner harbour and the iconic Empress Hotel. Later in the afternoon, we board the ferry once again and cruise leisurely back to the mainland and our hotel. Enjoy a snack or full dinner (on your own) as we cruise through the beautiful islands of the Salish Sea.

DAY 3 | ROCKY MOUNTAINEER - VANCOUVER TO KAMLOOPS

Early this morning transfer to the railway station. Here, board the famous Rocky Mountaineer for your spectacular 2-day journey from Vancouver to Banff! Breakfast is served as the train pulls out of Vancouver and heads east through the lush Fraser River Valley. From your reclining seats in the SilverLeaf Service car, enjoy a spectacular view as you travel along the rugged cliffs of the Fraser River surrounded by the peaks of the Coastal and Cascade Mountains. Be prepared to be spoiled as your service crew provides you with constant refreshments and enjoy a gourmet lunch in your own dining room. Later in the day, the train follows the Thompson River system and climbs to the desert-like interior plateau. Your day concludes as we travel along the shores of Lake Kamloops to the city of Kamloops

DAY 4 | ROCKY MOUNTAINEER - KAMLOOPS TO BANFF

This morning, board the train and enjoy a hearty breakfast while viewing the spectacular scenery that surrounds you. The journey continues east along the banks of the Shuswap Lakes before entering three uniquely different and rugged mountain ranges and river valleys. At the rail community of Field British Columbia, the train starts its long climb up through the historic Spiral Tunnels, emerging in the Province of Alberta and Banff National Park. Following the Bow River eastward, the train enters the resort community of Banff where the amazing rail journey comes to an end. After dinner take some time to explore the shops, galleries and museums of this iconic resort.

DAY 5 | ICEFIELD PARKWAY, ICE EXPLORER - JASPER

This morning you'll travel on one of the most scenic highways in the world - The Icefield Parkway. Enjoy the commentary of your step-on-guide as you journey north along the Bow River and a stop at azure blue Bow and Peyto Lakes. You'll journey through two majestic mountain passes on your way to the amazing Columbia Icefields, one of the largest glacier masses in North America. Ride on the Athabasca Glacier in a specially built Ice Explorer. In the afternoon, we retrace our route through the spectacular scenery. This is a great time to watch for wildlife including bears, elk, moose and mountain goats. Your spectacular day comes to an end as we travel along the banks of the Bow River, returning to our hotel in Banff in time for a relaxing dinner.

DAY 6 | LAKE LOUISE & BANFF

A leisurely morning drive along the banks of the Bow River brings us to the "Jewel of the Rockies", Lake Louise. You will have time to view the lake and the Victoria Glacier from many angles plus explore the iconic Chateau Lake Louise. We'll return to Banff in time for lunch (on your own) then take a scenic tour of this iconic resort. Pass by the castle-like Banff Springs Hotel before stopping to view spectacular Bow Falls and the mystical Hoodoo rock formations. We'll stop to view beautiful Lake Minnewanka and finish the tour at the historic Cave and Basin, the birthplace of Banff National Park originated over 150 years ago. The rest of the afternoon is free to explore the shops and galleries of Banff, or perhaps take a leisurely walk along the banks of the Bow River. This evening we'll board the comfortable (and safe) gondolas for a smooth ride to the top of 6500 ft Sulphur Mountain. The panorama views are spectacular. We'll enjoy our final dinner together in one of the beautiful restaurants on the mountain tops. What a magnificent way to bring this wonderful tour to an end!

DAY 7 | CALGARY & RETURN FLIGHT HOME

This morning we say goodbye to the majestic Rocky Mountains and board our coach for the 90-minute journey to the Calgary International Airport and our return flight home. You will arrive in Oklahoma City, OK around 9:45pm and head back to Perry, OK on an airport transfer.
